3. Three letters of recommendation
4. Scholastic Aptitude Test/American College Test (SAT/ACT) assessment scores (not applicable to undergraduates)
5. Original sealed high school transcript or current college transcript with at least a 2.5 GPA

These documents must be **MANUALLY** submitted to the address listed on page 3. **Applicants will be disqualified if all required documents are not mailed and postmarked by May 8, 2020.** Please print or type all information.
